

MASTER OF PUBLIC HEALTH CURRICULUM

The Master of Public Health (MPH) at St. Ambrose University is a 43 credit hour, online curriculum sequence with an applied practicum (approximately 200 hours) and integrated learning experience. Additionally, students complete electives, an internship, and a capstone project.

Students can begin this program in the Fall, Spring, or Summer semesters. Classes in the Fall and Spring semesters are split into two sessions, indicated in the course sequences as "Fall I" and "Fall II."
